L'ASSOCIATION DE COOPERATION ECONOMIQUE

TUNISIE ASIE (TUNISASIA)

SIGNED IN TUNIS

DECEMBER 12, 1983

The Delegation of Korean Construction Cooperation

Mission made a visit to Tunisia on December 10, 1983, and held
the joint meeting with the TUNISASIA in an amicable atmosphere
and both sides agreed to the joint statement as follows;

The purpose of the mission was to broaden the friendly relations between the two countries and to encourage joint ventures between Korean and Tunisian Companies in the field of construction in the Arab and African countries, especially in North Africa, where both parties deem cooperation desirable.

It was agreed that both the O.C.A.K. and TUNISASIA of Tunisia would actively explore ways and means of establishing closer relationship, and would take appropriate measures to increase cooperation in the field of construction by means of:

- 1) TUNISASIA's happy engagement in encouraging and facilitating Tunisian Construction Companies to cooperate with their Korean counterparts,
- Exchange of information and documentation on construction activities and construction markets,

3) Active participation of both sides in the transmission and promotion of construction technology through training engineers and technicians by invitation and exchange of expertise.

Both sides agreed that it would be advantageous for representatives of the two parties to meet when necessary in order to discuss and further enhance the implementation of this statement and to exchange information on the progress of various programs, projects and other activities of common interest, and also agreed that regular joint meeting will be held alternately in Seoul and Tunis.

Consideration will be given to a return industrial cooperation mission to Korea in 1984.
